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## **Dear friends of choir music and folklore,**

“Unique and exemplary” was the impression the Second German Television Station (ZDF) had of the first HARMONIE Festival in 1981. From **June 2 to 6, 2011**, choirs and folklore groups with thousands of participants from throughout the world will be coming together again in Lindenholzhausen, the “smallest festival town in Germany”, where the sixth HARMONIE Festival is to take place.

Lindenholzhausen belongs to the city of Limburg/Lahn, which is considered one of the most attractive places in Germany with its picturesque old town and cathedral, which is over 750 years old.

The organizer of the festival, the choir **HARMONIE Lindenholzhausen** with its 80 members, has built up an international circle of friends while making concert tours and participating in festivals in Egypt, England, Greece, the Netherlands, Latvia, Macedonia, Russia, Austria, Switzerland, Czech Republic, Hungary and Wales. The greatest success to date has been at the renowned competition “International Musical Eisteddfod” in Llangollen (Wales) as well as national prizes at the “German Choir Competition”. Choirs from many European countries, as well as from Africa, America and Asia, have given concerts here and were guests of the “HARMONIE” families.

**The HARMONIE FESTIVAL, with its international choir and folklore events and competitions, is considered as one of the most outstanding music festivals in the world. In 2005, more than 230 choirs and folklore groups representing 46 countries came to the fifth HARMONIE FESTIVAL. Patron was the Chancellor of the Federal Republic of Germany, Gerhard Schröder.**

The following areas will be assessed:

#### **a) technical performance**

Intonation, rhythm, phrasing, articulation

#### **b) artistic Performance**

Tempo, agogic, dynamics, interpretation of the text, stylistic accuracy, overall tone of the choir, sense of feeling, appropriate compilation of the programme.

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Scoring of the entire programme is assessed correspondingly for “Technical Performance” and “Artistic Performance” on the basis of a scale of points from 1 - 25, whereby certain standards of performance form the basis of individual points. An average score will be calculated for each choir from the total number of points awarded by the adjudicators.

“Participated with outstanding success” HARMONIE FESTIVAL- Certificate in Gold	25.0 to 23.0
“Participated with very great success” HARMONIE FESTIVAL-Certificate in Silver	22.9 to 21.0
“Participated with great success” HARMONIE FESTIVAL- Certificate in Bronze	20.9 to 16.0
“Participated with success”	15.9 to 11.0
“Participated”	10.9 to 1.0

Each choir receives a certificate with the corresponding distinction.

**The adjudicators’ decision is incontestable.**

- The choir with the highest average score in a category will receive the **HARMONIE FESTIVAL Prize** (work of art). This prize will be awarded once in each category.
- The choir with the highest average score in competition hall A will receive the **Prize of the Chancellor of the Federal Republic of Germany**. Participating choirs in categories 10 - 14 cannot be taken into account for the awarding of this prize.
- The choir with the highest average score in competition hall B will receive the **Prize of the President of the Parliament of the Federal Republic of Germany**. Participating choirs in categories 10 –14 cannot be taken into account for the awarding of this prize

## **Extra prizes**

The following prizes (money or works of art) can be awarded by the adjudicators:

- for the outstanding interpretation of a contemporary composition (past 1970)
- for the outstanding interpretation of a Romantic composition
- for the outstanding interpretation of a work of classical vocal polyphony
- for outstanding artistic performance

**A fund of 5000 Euro is available for these extra prizes. The adjudicators make the final decision about the awarding of each prize and the corresponding amount.**

## General Conditions and Instructions for choirs

Only performances without instrumental accompaniment are permitted in the choir competition. The only exception is category 14. In principle, it is possible for a choir to participate in more than one category. More detailed information can be found in the summary “**Categories for choirs**” (enclosure 1).

Only amateur choirs are allowed to participate. Professional choirs or singers are excluded from competitive participation. Conductors, however, may be professional musicians. A choir can appear with more than one choral director. Three scores of each the performances chosen by the choirs themselves are to be sent to the organizer **by March 1, 2011, at the latest.**

## 1. Conditions of entry for all participants – choirs and folklore groups

- Registration for participation in the HARMONIE FESTIVAL 2011 should be submitted to the organizer by **January 31, 2011**, at the latest. Please use the enclosed **entry-form (enclosure 2)**. Late registrations can only be accepted with reservation.
- A short account about the choir or group and their previous appearances, a photo, which can be copied, and an audio recording (DVD or CD - live performances are preferred), which is not older than two years has to be included. For choirs in categories 7 and 8 (Youth and Children’s Choirs) a list of names with dates of birth is also required.
- Choirs participating solely in concerts can only be accepted to a limited number.
- The organizer will make a decision concerning acceptance to the competitions and events by **February 1, 2011**.
- Each choir has to transfer a participation fee of **150 Euro** (not for each category) along with the registration form

The participant choirs and groups declare themselves willing to co-operate in productions by television and radio (organizer is HARMONIE Lindenholzhausen) and relinquish any claim to remuneration. All choirs participating in the festival can contribute to the concerts. Choral works of your own choice (performance time: limited to 8 min.) are to be performed. Registration for participation must accompany the registration for the festival. The organizer decides about the participation. The St.-Jakobus church can be found on the festival ground.
