Dear friends of choir music and folklore,

“Unique and exemplary” was the impression the Second German Television Station (ZDF) had of the first HARMONIE FESTIVAL in 1981. From **May 9 to 12, 2024**, choirs and folklore groups with thousands of participants from throughout the world will be coming together again in Lindenhofhausen, the “smallest festival town in Germany”, where the eighth HARMONIE FESTIVAL is to take place.

Lindenhofhausen is part of the city of Limburg/Lahn, which is considered one of the most attractive places in Germany with its picturesque old town and cathedral, which is over 750 years old.

The organizer of the festival, the choir **HARMONIE Lindenhofhausen** with its 70 members, has built up an international circle of friends while concert tours and participating in festivals in Egypt, England, Greece, the Netherlands, Latvia, Macedonia, Russia, Austria, Switzerland, Czech Republic, Hungary, USA and Wales. At international choir competitions HARMONIE has been the prize-winner several times. The greatest success to date has been at the Music Festival in Llangollen (Wales), the international Male Voice Choir Festival in Cornwall (England) as well as national prizes at the “German Choir Competition”. Choirs from many European countries, as well as from Africa, America and Asia, have given concerts in Lindenhofhausen where they were guests of the “HARMONIE” families.

The HARMONIE FESTIVAL, with its international choir and folklore events and competitions, is considered one of the most outstanding music festivals in the world. In 2017, more than 200 choirs and folklore groups representing 35 countries came to the seventh HARMONIE FESTIVAL. Patron was the Prime Minister of the Federal State of Hesse, Volker Bouffier.

Radio and television channels from several countries and a high number of newspapers and journals unanimously reported on the well-organized and high standard of competitions, folklore events, concerts and supporting events.

In 2005 the Second German Television Station (ZDF) reported: “An unforgettable experience in the smallest festival city in Germany, an unbelievably large celebration with song and dance in competitions and concerts in which one sees the coming together of folks of different nationalities in an atmosphere of unity.” This statement accurately describes the demand of this festival which exceeds the purely competitive atmosphere.

Artistic director of the HARMONIE FESTIVAL 2024 is Jürgen Faßbender.

You are sincerely invited to take part in the HARMONIE FESTIVAL 2024 and we are looking forward to seeing you in Germany and in Limburg-Lindenhofhausen.

1.4 Artistic Director

Artistic director of the HARMONIE FESTIVAL 2024 is the musical director of the HARMONIE, Jürgen Faßbender.

Musical advisors for the festival are Manfred Bender, Andreas Jung, Jan Schumacher and Martin Winkler.

1.5 Scoring

The following areas will be rated:

a) Technical Performance

Intonation, rhythm, phrasing, articulation

b) Artistic Performance

Tempo, agogic, dynamics, interpretation of the text, stylistic accuracy, overall tone of the choir, appropriate compilation of the program.

Scoring of the entire program is rated correspondingly for “Technical Performance” and “Artistic Performance” on the basis of a scale of points from 1 - 25, whereby certain standards of performance form the basis of individual points. An average score will be calculated for each choir from the total number of points awarded by the jury.

Each choir receives a certificate with the corresponding distinction.

The jury’s decision is incontestable.

1.6 Prizes

Categories with compulsory choral work (1,2,3) Euro 500 (*) will be awarded to the choir with the highest average score.

Categories without compulsory choral work (4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13) Euro 300 (*) will be awarded to the choir with the highest average score.

(*) **in case of equal points, the price will be divided**

- The choir with the highest average score in a category will receive the **HARMONIE FESTIVAL Prize** (work of art). This prize will be awarded once in each category.
- The choir with the highest average score in competition will receive the **Grand Prix**.

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Extra prizes

The following prizes (money or works of art) can be awarded by the jury:

- for the outstanding interpretation of a contemporary composition (past 1970)
- for the outstanding interpretation of a romantic composition
- for the outstanding interpretation of a work of classical vocal polyphony
- for outstanding artistic performance

A fund of 5000 Euro is available for these extra prizes. The jury makes the final decision about the awarding of each prize and the corresponding amount.

1.7 General Conditions and Instructions

Only amateur choirs are allowed to participate. Professional choirs or singers are excluded from competitive participation. Conductors, however, may be professional musicians. **Application deadline is November 30, 2023.** The competition literature has to be reported at the latest by **January 31, 2024** latest to the organizer. Three scores of each the performances chosen by the choirs themselves have to be sent to the organizer at the latest by March 1, 2024.

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2 Conditions of Entry for all Participants

- Registration for participation in the HARMONIE FESTIVAL 2024 should be submitted to the organizer at the latest by **November 30, 2023**. Late registrations can only be accepted with reservation.
- Please use the entry form (Choir Competition/Folklore International) for the registration on our website (www.harmonie-festival.de).
- A short account about the choir or group and their previous performances, a digital photo and an audio recording has to be included. For choirs in categories 7 and 8 (Youth and Children's Choirs) a list of names with dates of birth is also required. This list can be submitted until **May 1, 2024**.
- Choirs participating solely in concerts can only be accepted to a limited number.
- The organizer will make a decision concerning acceptance to the competitions and events by **December 15, 2023**.
- Each choir has to transfer a participation fee of **200 Euro** (not for each category) along with the registration form.

- Choirs or groups, which only want to participate on an exchange basis, can - in as far as addresses are available to the organizer - receive the contact address of a German choir.
- The organizer reserves the right to make audio and visual recordings of the performances of choirs and groups and to broadcast these recordings without payment to the performers of the events recorded. The participating choirs and groups declare themselves willing to co-operate in productions by television and radio (organizer is HARMONIE Lindenhofhaus) and relinquish any claim to remuneration. The production also includes camera persons filming or making recordings during competitions on the stage. At the same time, the participating choirs and groups transfer all rights of exploitation to the organizer, in particular the exclusive broadcasting rights without limitation regarding time, location and content without limitation to audio and visual material produced by inclusion of their aforementioned appearances - including those sent to the organizer -, and also including grant of such to a third party and for social media.
- In the case of force majeure, labour disputes such as strikes, political unrest, measures taken by the authorities, and otherwise unpredictable or unavoidable events relieve the organizer of their assumed obligations for the length of the disturbances and the extent of their results.

The organizer reserves the right to make any necessary alterations to this announcement. This announcement and all conditions are recognized and accepted with registration for the festival. With regard to any other enquiries, the organizer's decisions are binding.

The final schedule of the festival will be sent to the choirs and groups in **March 2024** at the latest.

All foreign choirs and groups will be looked after by members or friends of "HARMONIE" Lindenthal during their participation in the festival. A special ground area with the following facilities is available at the HARMONIE FESTIVAL 2023:

The city of Limburg is directly situated at the motorway A3 and the high-speed railway (ICE) between Frankfurt (60 km) and Cologne (100 km). Within one to two hours by coach or train you can reach:

- the famous Rhine valley between Mainz and Koblenz with the city of Rudesheim and the Lorelei (since 2002 World Heritage Site)
- the cities of Cologne, Koblenz, Mainz, Wiesbaden, Frankfurt/Main and Heidelberg.

For all participating choirs and groups on Friday, the 10th of May, 2024, the city of Limburg will organize a greeting ceremony in the town hall of Limburg and a guided sightseeing tour.
